



18th Century Antique

A late 18th century, French, Limestone trumeau chimney piece with over mantle. The jambs in the form of bracket shaped consuls decorated with flutes, upholding the frieze which is carved at the centre with a diamond shaped lozenge and flanked by a band of flutes mirroring the jambs. The over mantle with inset fielded rectangular panel flanked by ionic capped pilasters. See *Cheminees des pays de la Loire du moyen age* by Clement d' Armont for other similar examples.
