A Louis XVI Carrara marble chimneypiece. French, circa 1870. The rectangular top with rounded corners. The frieze with inset moulded panel carved with two lilies tied with bowed ribbons to sprays of laurel, symbolic of peace and victory. The jambs in the form of tapering half rounded fluted columns with acanthus decorated caps. The opening framed with moulded slips.
