



19th Century Antique

A good early 19th century Regency period chimney piece, nicely proportioned and decorated with a slight Gothic revival design with simple reeded shelf, convex moulded frieze the pilaster shaped jambs fronted with slender Doric clustered columns with rounded socles and caps supporting the square blockings decorated with rounded paterae. The jambs sides edged with fluted mouldings as is the fire opening, the whole on footblocks.

Originally from Charlemont Place, a terrace of five very grand cut Portland stone houses. Designed by William Murray for Lord Charlemont in 1827, it is considered to be one of the finest Georgian terraces in Ireland.
